



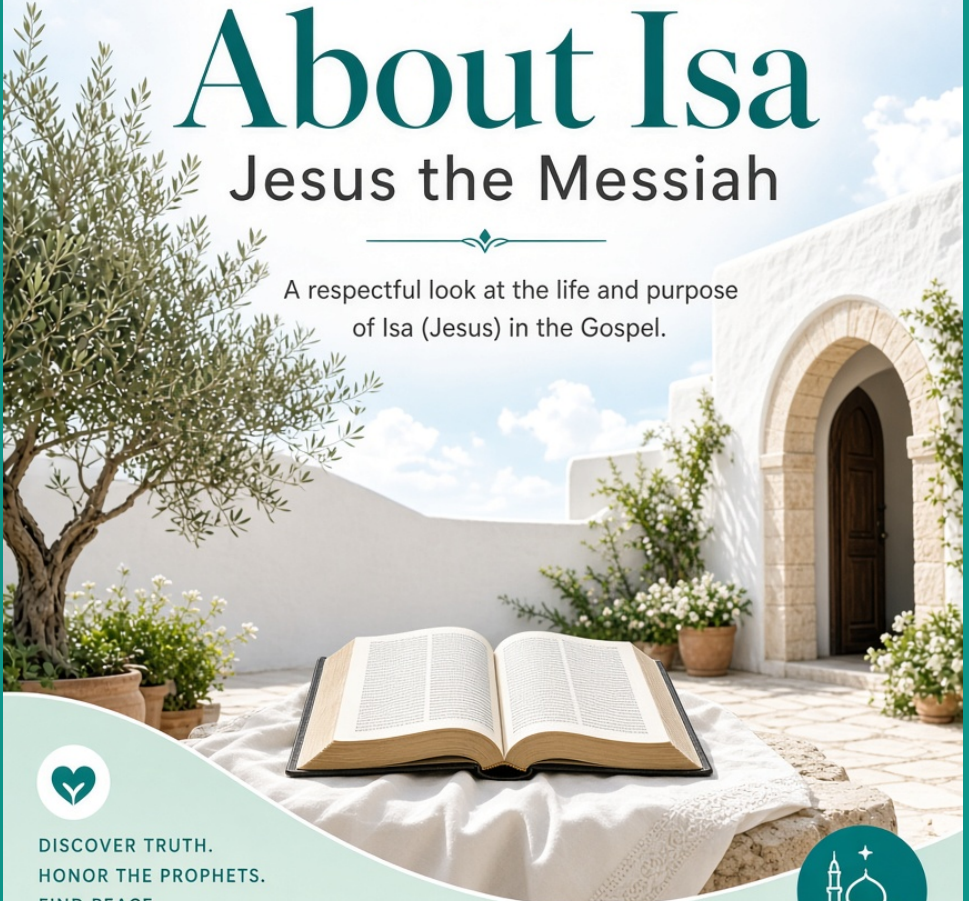

A Word About Isa

Jesus the Messiah — an invitation to look closer



Peace to you. As-salamu alaykum — may the seeker find truth.



You already know that **Isa (Jesus)** is honored. Many know Him as a prophet, the Messiah, born of Maryam by God's power — pure and mighty in word and deed. Many Muslims love and respect Him.

Christians do too — and we believe there is more in His story than many have heard.



What Christians believe about Isa



Isa is more than a messenger — the Word of God made flesh.



Not a second god, but the one true God drawing near in love.



He lived without sin.



He was crucified — the sacrifice that takes away sin.



God raised Him from the dead; He is alive forever.

This is the heart of the **Injil (the Gospel)**:

God so loved the world that He gave His only Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life.

— John 3:16



Why this matters

Every sincere heart knows: we fall short. We try harder — more prayer, more good deeds — and still feel guilt and the fear of judgment.

The Gospel does not say, “Try harder and hope you have done enough.” It says: **God Himself has provided the way.**



Isa said:

“I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.”

— John 14:6

Not through our own perfection — through His mercy and finished work.



An honest invitation

We do not ask you to hate your family, your culture, or your longing for God. We invite you to look carefully at Isa Himself.



A sincere prayer

O God of Abraham, I seek You with a sincere heart. I believe that Isa the Messiah lived, died, and rose again for the forgiveness of sins. I trust Him as Savior and Lord. Forgive me, cleanse me, and lead me in Your truth. Amen.

Read the Injil — begin with Luke or John. Ask God to show you the truth. He hears the sincere seeker.
